A look at how we prepare our trees for different projects around the village.

**July 15**

**This Old Wigwam**

A hands on demonstration of how we fix and repair our wigwams.

**August 19**

**Not just arrowheads**

Join us at the Indian village where we will show you how to flint knap and talk about the different uses of stone.

**September 16**

**Bones- From Eww! to Awesome!**

Visitors will get a chance to try and make and use some bone tools and see just how wonderful this material is.

**October 21**

**Harvest time**

This program focuses on the variety of wild and farmed edibles that would have been available to Native Americans over 400 years ago.
